1. Venue

The meeting will be held at the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission of UNESCO in Room VII on level -1.

2. Opening/Closure

The 27th Session of the GCOS Steering Committee will start on **Monday 28 October 2019 at 14:00 hrs** and end on **Thursday 31 October at 12:30 hrs**.

All-day sessions on Tuesday and Wednesday will run from 09 00 hrs - 17 00 hrs

3. Arriving in Paris and public transport information

Paris is a central hub of Europe. It can be reached by flights from many parts of the world and has six major train stations.

<u>Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport</u> is the largest international airport in France, located north of Paris. The airport website also gives the quickest and most economic route to go to/from the airport. You will find taxis at the exit to the baggage reclaim area of the arrival terminal. Fixed fares are around 50 euros.

<u>Paris Orly Airport</u> is located 13 km south of Paris. The airport is linked to Paris by freeways, Air France buses, RATP buses (called OrlyBus) and the Orlyval automatic metro service, which connects to the Antony (Paris RER) station. For more information see the website. You will find taxis at the exit to the baggage reclaim area of the arrival terminal. Fixed fares are around 30 euros.

The <u>Paris Régie Autonome des Transports Parisiens</u> (RATP) website has a <u>leaflet</u> on 'how to get to the airports.

Paris has six major train stations (<u>Paris by train</u>) in the city centre, each serving different regions of France and Europe. Trip Advisor gives a nice overview of all the stations in Paris and where they serve. Paris Gare du Nord also hosts Eurostar, which can get you from London to Paris in around 2 and a half hours.

5. Passports and visa

Please check if you need a visa before travelling to France as visas are not available at border crossings or at Paris airports: https://france-visas.gouv.fr/. France-Visas is a single portal with all the information you need to guide you through the process and help you every step of the way (preparing the application, entering details, submitting and tracking the application).

All delegates will be personally responsible for ensuring that they are in possession of the correct documentation prior to their departure.

6. Useful information

Climate: The average daytime temperature in Paris in October is $15/16^{\circ}$. Nights average $7/8^{\circ}$. The average overall temperature is $15/16^{\circ}$ factoring in night and day.

Currency: Euros (€). Visa, Master Card, Diners and American Express are widely accepted.

Electrical supply: The voltage in France is 220 to 240 Volts.

Health: No vaccinations are required to travel to France. It is suggested that you hold personal medical insurance for the duration of your trip. EU passport holders have access to the French social security system, which reimburses up to 70% of medical costs.

Security: Like all major cities in the world, Paris is not free of petty crime, such as pick pocketing, especially in major tourist areas. Visitors are advised to exercise caution and ensure that all valuables including tickets, passports and documents, are kept in a safe place at all times.

Time zone: GMT +1 hour

Water: Tap water in Paris is safe to drink.
