


Update on ISC Activity

- 1. Put in place an efficient and energetic governance system
- 2. Developed and implemented forward-looking strategies, policies and work plans focused on operationalizing the ISC vision and mission






Important outcomes from the ISC 2nd General Assembly

- 1. Adoption of the 2022-2024 Action Plan, with 27 initiatives (incl. 5 new)
- 2. Adoption of 2 resolutions
 - In favour of coordinated action in favour of necessary reform of the scientific publishing industry
 - Welcoming the UN SG's intention to re-establish the Scientific Advisory Board and to develop a strategy that mobilizes the expertise of members, scientific networks and partners
- 3. Consultation toward the finalisation of a Discussion Paper to frame the ISC's action to protect scientific freedom and advance the responsible conduct of science in the 21st Century

The ISC and Climate Science

- 1. Co-Sponsor of GCOS and WCRP, as well as GOOS and SCOR
- 2. Active Engagement in COP 26
 - Transform 21 platform
 - Involvement in UK-led Climate Risk Assessment initiative
 - Discussions for role in COP 27
- 3. New Action Plan includes a new, globally coordinated action on climate emergency, drawing lessons learned from COVID-19
